SORDO

The Sordo winery was established in the early twentieth century. It was 1912 when Giuseppe Sordo, the first generation of the family, began growing vines and making wine. The winery's wine production perfectly expresses the value of an area that has always been devoted to the production of great wines appreciated all over the world. The vineyards reach a total area of 53 hectares planted with vines.

Garblet Suè 2022

- Roero Arneis DOCG - 13,5% Vol. - 100% Arneis -



Beautiful expression of Arneis, characterized by a very delicate straw yellow color with greenish highlights. Its bouquet is broad, fragrant with hints of fresh fruit, acacia flowers and honey. The taste is dry, harmonious, with good body and great flavor. It goes well with both appetizers and dishes with gentle, delicate flavors, such as white risottos or with asparagus. Perfect as an aperitif. The delicacy of the dishes will be enhanced by the finesse of the bouquet, the savoriness and the compelling harmony of an important Piedmontese wine.



KALTERN

Kaltern is a historic cooperative representing the entire municipality of Kaltern and its wine producers. Today, Cantina Kaltern is one of the most important wineries in South Tyrol and is the spokesperson for the wines that are born close to Lake Kaltern. The history of Cantina Kaltern dates back to the early 20th century. A century that chronicles the troubled fortunes of five wineries through the years of war and the separation of South Tyrol from Austria. In the twenty-first century it became a wine cooperative with 650 members and 450 hectares of vineyards.

The white wine "Carned" is a pure Kerner, a little-known grape variety that, in Italy, finds in the Alto Atesino terroir one of the rare places of election. Cantina di Caldaro is a master at presenting this grape with an exotic profile in its aromas, a prelude to a precise and careful sip, refreshing on the palate. It reveals itself to the eye with a color reminiscent of straw yellow, very intense. The olfactory profile develops on an aromatic texture, with notes of fruit, also exotic, enriched by a slight nuance that brings back coconut milk. The palate is full-bodied, mediumbodied, with a sip marked by a pleasantly fresh vein, well suited to be tasted with fresh cheeses or fish dishes, including raw.

CASTELLO DI BUTTRIO

Buttrio Castle is a historic winery located in the heart of the Colli Orientali del Friuli, particularly known for its production of excellent white wines, an expression of the richness and diversity of native Friulian grape varieties. Its history is rooted in the Middle Ages, when the castle dominated the Friulian plain. In the 1980s, the castle and surrounding land were purchased by the Felluga family, one of Friuli Venezia Giulia's most prestigious and historic wine families. The vineyards of Buttrio Castle stretch across the rolling hills of the Colli Orientali del Friuli, an area renowned for its viticultural vocation. The unique terroir, characterized by marly and arenaceous soils (ponca) and an ideal microclimate with temperature ranges between day and night, gives the grapes distinctive characteristics that translate into elegant, complex and long-lived wines.

Sauvignon 2023

- Friuli Colli Orientali DOC - 14% Vol. - 100% Sauvignon Blanc -



Sauvignon Blanc is one of the most unique grapes in the world. Rich in fragrant treasures, it is an aromatic ecstasy of flowers, wild fennel, citrus and tropical fruit. Its unmistakable aromaticity makes it loved immediately, and the enveloping pleasantness has earned it a strong legion of admirers. The roots, infiltrating the micro-cracks of the "ponca" of the Buttrio hills, are imbued with a mineral dowry of extraordinary character, and its charm vibrates with notes of honeysuckle and white peach.

TENUTA RONCI

Tenuta Ronci covers about 30 hectares on the rolling hills of the Ronci Valley of the same name, an evocative and unspoiled micro-area in the extreme south of Tuscia Viterbese, just outside Rome. The vineyards insist on tufaceous soils, of volcanic origin, rich in microelements that guarantee first to the grapes and then to the wine complexity and a great balance of taste. The agricultural and oenological project, which took shape here in the 1980s, was strongly inspired by Arturo Improta's knowledge and passion for French wines and in particular for Burgundy and Bordeaux. Hence the decision to plant grape varieties such as Chardonnay, Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot. The evolution of Tenuta Ronci has been constant: from a small experimental winery it has transformed into a modern project, equipped with advanced technologies designed to preserve the varietal characteristics of the grapes and produce wines of the highest quality.

- Chardonnay Lazio IGP - 13,5% Vol. - 100% Chardonnay -



Seductive right from the color that tends to golden. On the nose and palate there are scents of exotic fruits, white holes and in particular the scent of acacia holes. Smooth and elegant palate with a pleasant fnal of mint and honey. Accompanies fish dishes, tartare, shellfish and crustaceans but also smoked salmon (on buttered croutons!). Excellent as an accompaniment to white meats. Amazing persistence!

NODODIVINO

Nododivino, formerly known as Codicedivino, represents excellence in Abruzzo wine production, combining craftsmanship, technological innovation and a deep connection with the territory. Nododivino is a winery located in Ortona, in the province of Chieti, Abruzzo. It is a wine project born within the Abruzzo cooperative Citra, with the aim of creating a micro-production of excellent wines that best express the potential of the territory, enhancing the unique characteristics of Abruzzo's native grape varieties, particularly Montepulciano d'Abruzzo and Trebbiano d'Abruzzo. Production is deliberately limited to ensure the utmost care and attention to each stage of the production process.

Nodivino's Trebbiano C: encapsulates a symphony of flavors, which come together elegantly and leave a lasting impression with every sip. Golden yellow in color, the vibrant bouquet of floral notes mixed with hints of citrus and tropical fruits stands out on the nose. On the palate, Trebbiano C: reveals itself for its complexity, with a harmonious balance of fresh acidity and subtle sweetness, resulting in a refreshing finish of long persistence. Perfect paired with fresh fish bites and creamy cheeses, also excellent as an aperitif.



Feudi di San Gregorio is undoubtedly the most established Campania-based winery in our country, with a range of products to suit all palates, even the most discerning. Founded only around the mid-1980s, thanks to the join venture of two families, the Capaldo and the Ercolino, it has managed in a short time to gain a respected place among domestic and foreign wine companies thanks to a remarkable production of quality.

Falanghina del Sannio 2022

- Falanghina del Sannio DOC - 12,5% Vol. - 100% Falanghina -



Feudi San Gregorio's Falanghina del Sannio is a significant interpretation of this indigenous variety, not the usual banal wine, certainly drinkable and fresh but endowed with its own precise identity. Bright straw yellow, the nose explodes in sensations of broom and citrus, yellow peach and citron, cut grass and mineral notes of granite and pumice. The taste reveals a round but savory body, a good gustatory balance between softness and acidity and a pleasant finish full of citrusy returns. Ideal with seafood salads, zucchini risotto, sole meunière and spreadable cheeses.

VACCARO

The Vaccaro winery's success story began in the early 1970s when Giacomo Vaccaro and his wife Caterina purchased a small estate and fields in Salaparuta. In the immediate vicinity of the Duca di Salaparuta estates, they caused a stir with the quality of their grapes, so much so that in 1999 the family decided to build their own winery and produce the wines themselves. Apparently, this was the right decision. Today, the Vaccaros own more than 45 hectares of vineyards in three different locations: between 160 m and 400 m above sea level, there are different soil structures and microclimates for optimal ripening and growing conditions for the different grape varieties Grillo, Nero D'Avola, Syrah and Merlot.

Luna Grillo

- Sicilia DOC - 12,5% Vol. - 100% Grillo -



Grillo is an indigenous Sicilian grape variety born from a cross of Moscato and Catarratto. Greenish yellow in color, on the nose, Vaccaro's Luna Grillo is fresh and floral with notes of citrus and juicy grapefruit. On the palate, the aromas are reflected with a lively acidity that makes the white wine balanced and aromatic. On the finish, we have a pleasantly light reverberation. Perfectly paired with delicate fish dishes and crisp vegetables for an unforgettable taste experience. Also perfect as an aperiti.



Good persistence, perfect with various appetizers, with raw and fried fish, and vegetable flans; also to be tried with fresh cheeses and white meats.



Ruby red in color, it gives fruity sensations on the nose against a floral background of rose and violet. In the mouth it presents a good balance between structure and acidity. Suitable for first courses and main courses of meat.

- Amarone della Valpolicella DOCG- 14,5% Vol. - Corvina, Corvinone, Rondinella -



The name derives from the ancient Roman custom of storing wine in an amphora for aging in which Emperor Augustus' favorite wine was aged.

It is made from the classic Amarone blend, consisting of Corvina Veronese, Corvinone and Rondinella grapes. Following the harvest, the grapes are left to dry for 4 months, after which they ferment in contact with the skins at a controlled temperature and conclude vinification in oak barrels, enriching themselves with unique sensory nuances.

A wine with an intense ruby red color with garnet reflections, it expresses elegant aromas of ripe plums on

the nose, enriched by hints of dark chocolate. In the mouth it is harmonious and velvety, with remarkable balance.

Valpolicella Ripasso Superiore

- Valpolicella Ripasso DOC- 14,5% Vol. - Corvina, Corvinone, Rondinella -



Cantina Valpantena's Valpolicella Superiore Ripasso is a wine made from the Corvina, Corvinone and Rondinella grape varieties. After a crushing-destemming phase, the must ferments at a controlled temperature of 22-28°C with maceration on the skins for 12 days. This is followed by a second fermentation on the Amarone pomace, then aging for at least 12 months in Slavonian oak barrels. It is endowed in the glass with a beautiful deep ruby red color. The nose tells of fruits of the underbrush and jam. On the palate it is soft and balanced, with clear and precise oaky hints at the end of the mouth. It pairs perfectly with medium-long aged cheeses, hare and game of all kinds.

Caldaro Winery's Lagrein is a red that translates the meaning of South Tyrolean terroir into small, concentrated sips. In the glass it is a beautiful deep red. The nose expresses aromas of ripe red fruit, red plum, hints of underbrush and humus, hints of chocolate, roasting and spice. The sip is characterized by rich and fruity aromas, crossed by a tannic texture of nice thickness, which accompanies the sip towards a harmonious and balanced finish. A full and graceful sip, with tannin present that complements the total body well, giving a long and pleasant finish.

Brunello is made in Montalcino, the best area in the world for the Sangiovese grape variety. A type of vine grown in Montalcino for hundreds and perhaps thousands of years. Thanks to the climate and soil, it has taken on specific characteristics: it produces few grapes, with small clusters and small berries. This is why it is possible to create, in Montalcino, a great long-aged red wine, such as Brunello, using only one grape variety: Sangiovese. Brunello is the Italian wine that stays in the cellar the longest; it begins its marketing after five years from the harvest, at least two of which are aged in oak barrels.

Brilliant ruby red in color, the nose is refined and rich with references to red fruits, underbrush and spices. Pleasantly savory and almost silky in the mouth, lingering.

A wine for important lunches or dinners, it should be paired with aged cheeses, savory meats and intense but not fatty foods.

According to Casale del Giglio's philosophy, "the future development of Italian vitiviniculture lies not only in consolidating the image of areas with great tradition, but also in achieving, through appropriate viticultural and oenological choices, high-level productions, characterized by the right quality-price ratio, in territories that are still little known from the point of view of their viticultural and oenological quality potential." Winegrowing models are inspired by those practiced in Bordeaux, Australia and California, which are territories exposed to the influence of the sea exactly like the Agro Pontino.

Great expression of pure Shiraz this one from Casale del Giglio: deep, enveloping and fleshy. A beautiful ruby color with purple hues, it opens on the nose with loaded sensations of ripe small black fruits: sour cherry and currants above all, then pepper and licorice, herbs and balsamic nuances. On the palate it reveals great softness and structure, robust tannins, full correspondence and a spicy finish. It perfectly accompanies first courses with meat sauce, roast game, aged cheeses and, why not, a slice of grilled tuna.

Nodivino's Montepulciano d'Abruzzo is a red wine that embodies the typical characteristics of this important Abruzzo grape variety, with the winery's hallmark of quality and attention to detail. It is a pleasant wine to drink, with good structure and a fruity aromatic profile and interesting spicy notes. Deep ruby red in color, the nose is intense and fruity. On the palate it is a medium-bodied wine with a tannic structure that is present but generally well integrated and soft. It has good acidity that contributes to the wine's freshness and drinkability. The finish is persistent. It goes well with the tasty dishes typical of the Abruzzo tradition

Varvaglione's Primitivo di Manduria "Papale" is a tribute to the rich land of Puglia. A pure Primitivo that stands out for its intensity and fullness. VACCARO

The Vaccaro winery's success story began in the early 1970s when Giacomo Vaccaro and his wife Caterina purchased a small estate and fields in Salaparuta. In the immediate vicinity of the Duca di Salaparuta estates, they caused a stir with the quality of their grapes, so much so that in 1999 the family decided to build their own winery and produce the wines themselves. Apparently, this was the right decision. Today, the Vaccaros own more than 45 hectares of vineyards in three different locations: between 160 m and 400 m above sea level, there are different soil structures and microclimates for optimal ripening and growing conditions for the different grape varieties Grillo, Nero D'Avola, Syrah and Merlot.

This balanced Italian red wine is made from the Nero d'Avola grape variety. The vines that produce the grapes for this wine grow on volcanic rock soils in Sicily. When perfect physiological ripeness is assured, the grapes for the are harvested at particularly short times and during the coolest hours of the day to preserve their flavors. After manual harvesting, the grapes are immediately taken to the press. Here they are carefully selected and crushed. Fermentation takes place in temperature-controlled stainless steel tanks. Once fermentation is complete, Lisuli Nero d'Avola Sicilia can continue to harmonize on the fine lees for several months. It presents itself in the glass with a brilliant purple color. The nose of this Sicilian red wine seduces with notes of blackberry. On the palate it has an incredibly fleshy texture and impresses with its forthright, dry flavor.

Little guide to the Regions of Italy

Northern Italy:

- **Piemonte:** Full-bodied, aged reds characterized by robust tannins and complex aromas of ripe red fruit, spice and underbrush dominate. The whites are also of great quality.

- Lombardia: In addition to Franciacorta, a high-quality sparkling wine, Lombardy produces reds such as Valtellina Superiore and whites such as Lugana.
- Trentino-Alto Adige: Aromatic and mineral white wines, such as Gewürztraminer and Pinot Blanc, and spicy reds are produced here..
- **Friuli-Venezia Giulia:** Region characterized by a wide variety of grape varieties, both native and international. Aromatic whites, full-bodied reds and elegant rosés are produced.

Central Italy:

- **Toscana:** Tuscany is famous for its structured reds, such as Chianti Classico and Brunello di Montalcino. Elegant whites are also produced.
- **Marche:** Region rich in variety, with full-bodied and structured reds, such as Rosso Conero, and aromatic and mineral whites, such as Verdicchio.
- **Umbria:** In addition to Sagrantino di Montefalco, a deep, tannic red, Umbria offers a wide range of wines
- **Lazio:** A region with a long winemaking tradition, famous for its aromatic whites, such as Frascati, and structured reds, such as Cesanese del Piglio.
